Dear Congregations and Friends of Luther Heights Bible Camp,

With a sense of God's great purpose for Luther Heights and its ministry, the LHBC Board of Directors is pleased to announce that Kelly Preboski will be the camp's new executive director effective September 16.

Kelly has served for nearly four years as Camp Director for Pine Lake Camp, one of three camps with Crossways Camping Ministry, a Lutheran Outdoor Ministry site in Wisconsin. Prior to this, Kelly has been an education coordinator and teacher for two ELCA congregations, a classroom teacher at a parochial school, and as a young adult she served nine years in outdoor ministry, beginning as a summer counselor and concluding as a year-round program director. She has a Youth and Family Ministry Certification from Wartburg Theological Seminary.

The Luther Heights Search Committee, with representatives from across the constituency, recommended Kelly to the board of directors as their preferred candidate after a nation-wide search. A total of 13 people applied for the position, seven were invited to do a video interview, and three were invited for an in-person interview.

Kelly was the committee's unanimous choice for her ability to 1) articulate a clear faith in Jesus Christ and the Luther Heights faith tradition, 2) frame a vision for the future during this time of transition, 3) collaborate effectively with the Luther Heights board, constituency, and staff, 4) inspire others, and 5) serve as an ambassador for and emulate the values of Luther Heights.

Kelly and her family—husband Zach and sons Owen and Quinn—will be moving to Boise in September. Soon after Kelly's start date, she will begin visiting member congregations. Please welcome her and her family, and please keep Kelly and Luther Heights in your prayers as we continue the exciting, grace-filled ministry that God has planned for Luther Heights.
