

## INTROS

 1st - 3rd grade  July 5-8, July 19-22 **\$215**



Intros Camp is specifically designed to give younger youth a great introductory camp experience within a shortened time frame (Sunday - Wednesday). Campers will enjoy learning camp games and songs, exploring the trails, swimming at Alturas Lake, engaging in Bible study and joining the entire camp in worship.

## JUNIORS

 4th - 6th grade  June 14-19, July 5-10, July 19-24 **\$380**


Juniors Camp offers a full-week experience to youth and is intentionally designed to offer more choices for a unique camp experience. Afternoon activities include archery, hiking, canoeing, games, and the option to add on a 90-minute horseback ride. New this year will be an evening of cooking over a fire with a Dutch oven! Campers engage in daily Bible study with their cabin group, all-camp worship, and all-camp games.

## INTERMEDIATES

 7th - 8th grade  June 14-19, July 5-10, July 19-24 **\$380**

Intermediates Camp broadens a camper's experience of camp by creating time for team building, low-ropes, and leadership skill development. Campers will participate in daily Bible study, nightly devotions, camp worship and all-camp games. They will also spend one night away from camp, enjoying a longer hike, learning to cook their meals and experiencing a night under the stars. Option to add on a 90-minute horseback ride in the mountains.

## EXPLORING CAMPS

 multiple grades, based on-site with off-site activities



**TREKKERS CAMP** 8th - 12th grade August 2-7 **\$475\***

Trekkers Camp invites campers to enjoy a week of adventure and relaxation in the Sawtooth Valley. Day hike in the White Cloud and Sawtooth mountain ranges, canoe at Redfish Lake, go mountain biking, hit the trails for a half day of horseback riding, and go rock climbing! Relax in the hot springs and enjoy cooking outdoors. Campers will spend nights both on and off-site. \*All activities included in price.

**ADVENTURE CAMP** 9th - 12th grade July 12-17 **\$560\***

Adventure Camp is packed with exciting activities each day, including a full-day horseback ride and a rafting trip down the Salmon River! Campers return to camp each night to participate in all-camp games and evening worship with the on-site Senior High program. One night will be spent off-site camping under the stars. \*All activities included in price.

## SENIOR HIGH ON-SITE

 9th - 12th grade  July 12-17, July 19-24 **\$380**

Senior High Camp offers campers freedom in their daily adventures with opportunities to canoe, hike backcountry trails, and go swimming. Campers will spend one night under the stars with their cabin group, experiencing daily Bible study and worship around a campfire. Extra program offerings include horseback riding and a whitewater rafting trip.


**Evangelical Lutheran Book of Worship (ELW)**

Daily Bible studies will explore verses in the Old and New Testaments focusing on how God promises to walk with you today and everyday.

## LEADER IN TRAINING (L.I.T.)



9th - 12th graders - Apply online beginning February 3

Leader-In-Training (formerly Camphands) invites high school youth to participate in camp management and help lead cabin groups. L.I.T.s will serve and learn for one to two weeks, serving and cleaning in the kitchen, janitorial work, and other work projects around camp, as well as participate with counselors in cabin groups. Counselors and staff will mentor L.I.T.s, helping them learn what skills are needed to be a summer staff member. L.I.T.s will help lead special interest time and all-camp games, plus have devotions with a staff supervisor.

Nuclear family max of \$1,000 for youth programming (please email [info@lutherheights.org](mailto:info@lutherheights.org) to apply nuclear family discount). **Full payment of registration fee is due 30 days before the first day of camp.**

## EARLY BIRD DISCOUNT

Register by March 15 and receive a \$20 canteen credit to be used at camp! Canteen includes snack items and LHBC gear.

## HELPFUL INFO FOR ALL CAMPS & RETREATS

**Arrival:** Registration for all youth and family camp is from 3 - 5 PM on the first day of camp. Registration for retreats is 4 - 6 PM.

**Departure:** For youth programming, parents and guardians are encouraged to join us for closing worship at 11 AM on the last day of camp (Wednesday for intros, Friday for all other youth programs). Everyone is invited to a buffet-style lunch at noon. Campers must be picked up by 1 PM. Departure for retreats is Sunday morning after worship with an option for making a pack-out lunch.

**Directions:** Camp is located about 40 miles north of Ketchum, ID, and 25 miles south of Stanley, ID. Directions to camp, including the GPS coordinates, can be found on our website [www.lutherheights.org](http://www.lutherheights.org) under 'Programs.' Luther Heights can be found on both Apple Maps and Google Maps and will work even when losing cell service.

**Canteen:** The camp store includes camp apparel, snacks, and fun LHBC items including stickers and mugs. Canteen is open daily for youth programming and at the end of weekend retreats.
