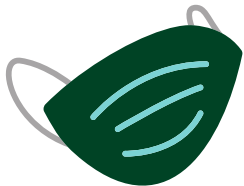
MULTI-LAYERED SCREENING

We will have a pre-screen document required for campers before program.
We will do temperature and symptom checks on-site daily.
We will require reporting of any positive test 14 days post camp.



HAND HYGIENE

Frequent hand washing and use of hand sanitizer required.



FACE COVERINGS

Face masks are required by campers, staff, and guests in all common areas and large group activities, including to and from meals.
Face masks to cover both mouth and nose.
Bandanas and buffs are not allowed.



ADJUSTED REGISTRATION

Registration times have changed to allow more time between groups to allow for thorough cleaning process.

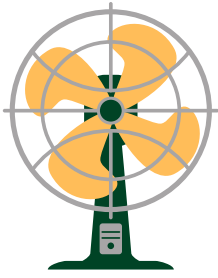
Registration is now 4 - 6 pm and Departure is 11 - 12 pm for all camps and retreats.

We adjusted Registration and Departure processes to limit exposure to campers and staff.



INCREASED CLEANING MEASURES

Common spaces and frequent services will be cleaned on a regular daily schedule.



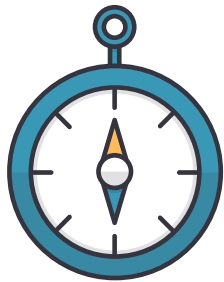
VENTILATION

Activities will be outdoors as much as possible. Windows will be open and air purifiers used to increase ventilation within indoor spaces.



PHYSICAL DISTANCING

6 or more feet of space or more between tables in the dining hall and when large group gatherings do occur.



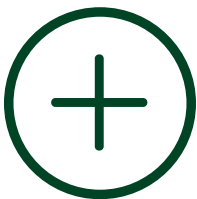
CABIN GROUPS & ACTIVITIES

Activities will be centered on small group activities with their cabin group. We are currently analyzing activities, such as games, and will adjust based on safety protocols. Trailblazers and Navigators will still be going on their campout overnight. Masks will not be required within small cabin groups, eating, and sleeping.



LIMITED CAPACITY AND CABINS

We will be operating youth camp at limited capacity. retreats and Family+ camps will operate as one group/cabin, or grouped with permission.



POSITIVE PROTOCOLS

We have plans in place for positive cases, including testing, communication, and quarantines.
