### HAND HYGIENE

Frequent hand washing and use of hand sanitizer required.

### VACCINATION

Luther Heights strongly recommends all campers and staff be up-to-date on COVID-19 vaccinations.

### CAMPER ACTIVITIES

Our programming focuses on outside activities and small group programming. We encourage low-risk behaviors for campers within two weeks prior to their camp start. Examples: avoiding large-group indoor gatherings, going to a movie theater, airplane travel.

### ON LOCATION DAY CAMPS

LH On Location day camps will follow church and city guidelines.

### FACE COVERINGS

Face masks are a personal choice for each camper. Masks are available on-site.

### MEALS

Meals will be served buffet-style with all kitchen staff wearing masks.

### TESTING

Rapid testing will be available for campers or staff if symptomatic. We have protocols in place for positive results, including positive campers going home, staff quarantine, and close-contact reporting.
